

Warrior Long Island Classic

Rules of Play

The LI Classic is a **LIMITED BODY CHECKING TOURNAMENT**. Limited body contact is most simply defined as always playing the ball if there is ever a choice between body and man. Limited body contact is allowed by defenders while defending the goal in applied pressure situations. **BLATANT BIG HITS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

National Federation High School Rules (counts included) will be in effect. This means there will be a 20-second count to clear the midline and a 10-second count to advance the ball into your offensive box upon crossing the midfield line.

Game Information

- All games will consist of 2-26 minute running time halves with a 3 minute halftime
- There will be no substitution horns during the game, all subs will be made on the fly
- No time outs allowed
- All penalties will be served, and time serving penalties will result in an extra man opportunity
- All teams are responsible for balls on their offensive end line (use your backup goalie to stand on your offensive end line)
- Ties will result in a 3-minute sudden death overtime period. If the score is tied after that, each team will be awarded one point for a tie in the standings. During playoffs, ties will be broken once a team scores (no time limit)
- Time will be kept by general site horn

Keeping Score

Following each game the coaches should check the score with the scorekeeper on each field to confirm it is accurate.

Seeding for all brackets playing to a Champion:

Seeding for the playoffs will be determined by point accumulated after last regular game on Saturday. At the conclusion of the last round robin game Saturday night, playoff/consolation game information will be posted on the website:

If teams total points (2 for win, 1 for tie, 0 for loss) are tied during round robin play, tie will be broken by:

Two-Team Tie

- 1. Head-to-Head result**
- 2. Goals against Average**
- 3. Goal Differential**
- 4. Coin Toss**

Three-Team Tie (or more)

- 1. Win percentage against tied teams**
- 2. Goals against Average**
- 3. Goal Differential**
- 4. Coin Toss**

In the **Varsity/Championship, 2020 Championship, 2021 Championship** and **2022** and **2023** brackets, the top four teams will make it to the playoffs.

In the **Varsity B** and **JV** brackets, you will play a five game schedule with no playoff format. And in the **2024/2025** bracket, you will play 3 games on Saturday only.

Any verbal abuse of an official or member of our tournament staff will be immediately removed from the tournament. Playing a player out of an age bracket will result in disqualification of the team from the tournament.
